Reminders

Car Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Just a reminder to please use your blinkers when you are pulling out of the parking lot. This helps our crossing guard. Also, if you are in the inner right lane, please go into the fire lane to allow for a wider left lane, making it easier for both lanes to move more safely. Again, please consider having your child/children ride the school bus.

Winter Clothes Reminder

Keep in mind that your children should be appropriately dressed and prepared for the daily weather/temperature, not only for recess, but also for any unexpected times that we may need to be out of the building. Texting / Messaging Your Children During the School Day

If your child messages you during the school day, please discourage that behavior and ask them to speak with their classroom teacher or school staff. Do NOT email your child's teacher with absence, tardy, transportation changes, or early dismissal information, as the teachers are often unable to check their email until after school hours. If your child is late arriving at school, please press the intercom to the right of the doors, and enter the building to sign them in.
